

AC Power Supplies Quick Start Guide

1. Introduction

2. Application

The device is designed to power the electrical equipment from the 110-230V AC mains.

3. Unit setup and operation

- Plug the connector into the appropriate socket in the powered device.
- Plug the power supply to the 110-230V AC outlet.

4. Precautions

- Do not exceed the rated operating parameters.
- The device may interfere with radio and television sensitive equipment located nearby.
- There is a risk of a harmless electric shock, fire or equipment failure. Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the device and do not touch the interior parts of the device.
- Do not disassemble the housing.
- The power supply has no components including fuses that can be replaced by the user.
- Dangerous voltages may still exist in the power supply even after few minutes from turning off the power.
- Damaged power cord must be immediately replaced by a qualified technician.
- Do not use the device if it emits smoke, an abnormal smell or strange sounds.
